Children & Youth

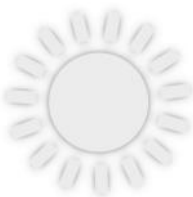
Raising kids is a great task. We want to help you raise them to grow into young men and women who love God. You love your kids. We do, too!

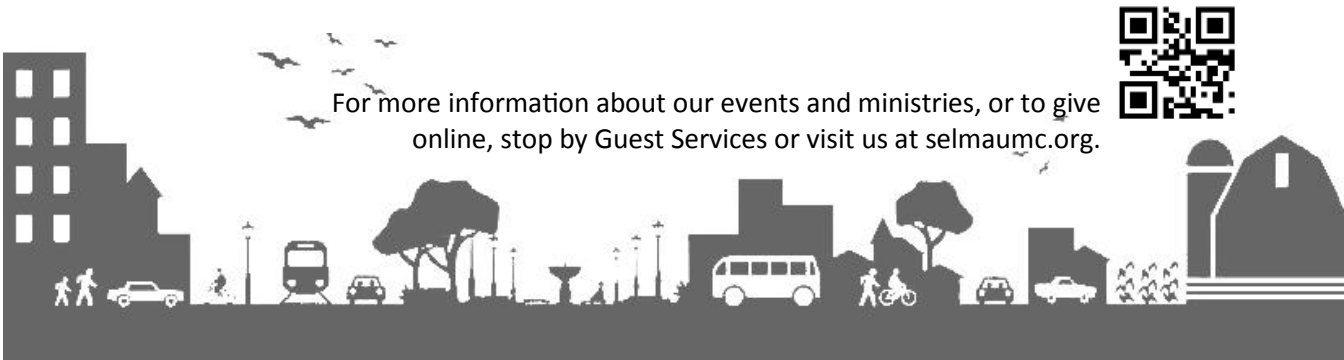
